NOTICE OF REVISION TO PROJECT DOCUMENTS

February 12, 2025

All bidders are notified of the following revisions to the contract documents which are made part of the contract.

PROJECT REVISION

- 1) Specifications Section 32 18 16.16
 - a. Under Section 2.1 "Acceptable Manufacturers and Installers", add 2.1.E as follows:
- 2.1.E A-Turf, an ECORE company, Williamsville, NY
 - b. Add section 2.5 as follows:
- 2.5 INFILL RE-USE
 - A. At the direction of the Owner, the Contractor shall investigate the existing infill material and its quality for reuse.
 - Contractor shall collect several samples of the existing infill over the entire field. The
 Contractor shall run all tests necessary to ensure that the existing material meets or exceeds
 the requirements of the infill per these specifications and minimum manufacturer's
 requirements. Rubber particle size shall meet these specifications and manufacturer's
 recommendations. Reusable infill shall be free of fiber and metal. Dust content shall be
 measured and checked to be within specifications and manufacturer's requirements. The
 existing rubber shall be checked to confirm it is in good, clean, and usable condition.
 - 2. Contractor shall submit to Owner certified letter confirming the existing infill material meets the requirements of these specifications and meets the manufacturer's minimum infill standards and will function like new.
 - 3. Owner shall approve the certification in writing prior to existing infill reuse.
 - B. Contractor shall collect the existing infill and store the material so that it is not subject to contamination.
 - C. Contractor and Owner or Owner's Representative shall inspect the collected material to ensure that it is consistent with the approved material as tested per Section 2.5.A. Any material not consistent with the approved material shall be rejected and disposed of by Contractor.
 - D. If there is not enough reusable material to meet the necessary amount of infill required for the project, the Contractor shall provide new infill material meeting these specifications as necessary.
 - E. There shall be no change to the Warranty for reuse of existing infill material.

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
